



Camp Employment Opportunity – Advanced First Aid Attendant

The Mount Nansen Remediation Project is seeking a first aid attendant with Advanced First Aid (or equivalent) for short-term coverage the site.

Location: Mount Nansen Remediation Site

Positions available: 1

Hourly wage: \$40/hour

Mileage payment: Mileage will be paid at \$0.70/km

Type of Work

1. Promptly providing injured workers with a level of care within the scope of training and referring injured workers to medical treatment if injuries are serious or beyond the scope of training.
2. Assist in coordination of medical emergency evacuations if necessary.
3. Proactively identify and prevent hazardous situations and take necessary measures to correct them.
4. Perform incident investigations and prepare incident reports, detailing all critical information.
5. Participate in daily tailgate talks.
6. Maintain readiness of the First Aid equipment in the field and in the First Aid room.
7. Support a positive culture of safety on-Site.
8. Maintain communication with site work crews and be aware of where personnel are working on site.

Expectations

1. Advanced First Aid or EMR certification (or equivalent) required.
2. Must possess a valid class 5 drivers license (unrestricted).
3. Must possess a clean Drivers Abstract.
4. Adhere to all MNRLP site safety and conduct rules.
5. Professionalism – respectful communication, tidiness, appropriate attire, working well with others, and contributing to a team.

Other Information

- Accommodation will be provided at the Mount Nansen bunkhouse.
- Catering is provided (includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks).
- Site personnel work 12-hour shifts per day with the morning safety meeting beginning at 7am.
